Building an Engaging Curriculum

Develop whole school consistent approach to pedagogy with a focus on STEM

Key Actions:

- Develop and/or review whole school agreements around Literacy, Numeracy, STEM and Critical & Creative Thinking
- Targeted professional development on STEM and Critical & Creative Thinking
- Review, modify and create consistency in planning to support STEM curriculum

Outcomes:

- Increase teacher capacity and further develop collaboration
- Transference of knowledge and explicit teaching evident in all classes
- Students experiencing a STEM based curriculum, enabling them to be critical and creative thinkers

Improving Learner Outcomes

Providing intellectual stretch for all students
Identify and enact clear intervention processes

Key Actions:

- Build and adopt a consistent approach for assessment, moderation and tracking student achievement
- Consistency in use of contemporary STEM facilities
- Provide intellectual stretch for all learners by using collaborative planning and learning design to support higher levels of achievement

Outcomes:

- Data consistently used by teachers to inform teaching practice
- 100% students making one year's growth in one year
- Students aware of 'next steps' to achievement

Student Wellbeing

Enabling all students to be powerful learners

Key Actions:

- Students providing feedback to teachers which is used to inform and adapt classroom pedagogy
- Student voice apparent throughout all classes and providing input on major school decisions
- Using formative feedback that is targeted and timely and includes transparent prompts aligned to clear shared success criteria

Outcomes:

- Students have strong ownership of their learning allowing them to become powerful learners
- Students have increased resilience and see failure as a critical element of learning
