Zucchini Tarts

You will need

- 1 chopping board
- 1 knife
- 1 cookie cutter
- 1 baking tray lined with baking paper

Ingredients

- 1/2 Zucchini
- 1 sheet puff pastry
- 1/2 cup of grated cheese
- Chives, thyme and decorative chive flowers

Method

1. Pre-heat oven to 220 degrees.
2. Cut zucchini into slices.
3. Use the cookie cutter to cut small circles out of the pastry.
4. Place 1 slice of zucchini on each pastry circle.
5. Place either herbs or chives on top each zucchini tart.
6. Place a sprinkle of cheese on top of each tart.
7. Arrange tarts on baking tray and bake for 10-15mins.
8. Decorate cooked tarts with flowers.
