Hi All,

On Monday and Tuesday of this week our staff joined with Huntfield Heights Primary School to undertake training in Berry Street Education. The Berry Street Education Model was designed to meet the educational needs of all students by creating strengths-based classrooms, with the belief that students flourish when the school has high expectations and when students receive support that best meets their individual goals. The Berry Street Education Model has been designed with the following principles and values:

- Strong relationships matter. Every student must feel they have an advocate in their school, as students learn best from teachers they love and respect.
- Teachers can make a difference.
- Visible learning and stamina are of the greatest importance in building students' understandings of their daily successes when developing a growth mindset.
- Students need safe and predictable classrooms and schools must work towards shared and consistent expectations for students and teachers.
- All students must have the opportunity to understand themselves and how they learn.

It was fantastic to see 60 staff members from two different schools totally engaged in what they were learning. Staff have come away enthusiastic, energised and eager to put into practice what they learned. The Berry Street Education Model professional development stands as one of the most valuable professional development opportunities I have had to date. I am eagerly looking forward to seeing staff bring their learning to life in the classroom, and the impact this will have on the learning outcomes for our students.
