Welcome back to school and term 2. I am pleased to report that students have settled quickly back into class and learning which is wonderful to see.

We have already had some wonderful news this week with our students being overall winners at the 2019 Division 3 SAPSASA athletics competition. Congratulations to all the students who participated it was a fantastic way to start the term!

This term will see year 3, 5 and 7 students participate in NAPLAN. All NAPLAN tests will be held in week 3. They will all be online tests with the exception of year 3 writing which is still completed on paper. Students in these year levels are currently looking at NAPLAN online and how to navigate the system through a trial website during their ICT lessons.
