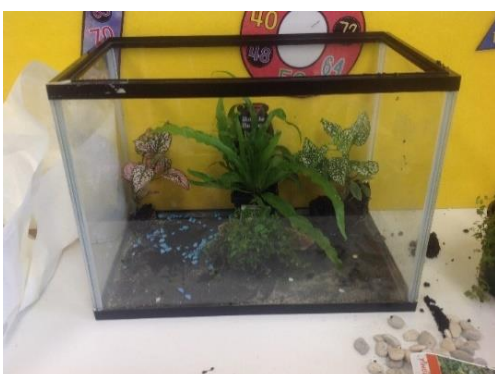
This is stone fruit with rose water fruit.
